


Recruitment Rules for the post of Siddha Pharmacist

6	Age limit for direct recruits	Between 18 and 27 years of age (relaxable for Government servants according to orders/instructions issued by the Central Government from time to time Note: The crucial date for determining the age limit shall be the closing date for receipt of applications from candidates in India (and not the closing date prescribed for those in Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Ladakh Division of J&K state, Lahul&Spiti district of Himachal Pradesh, Andaman & Nicobar islands and Lakshadweep)
7	Educational and other qualifications required for direct recruitment	Essential: 1) 12th Class or equivalent qualification with Science subjects from a recognised Board or University 2) Diploma in Integrated Pharmacy of two years duration conducted by a recognised Board/ University/ Institution with Siddha as one of the subjects or Diploma in Siddha (Pharmacy) of two years duration conducted by a recognised Board/ University/ Institution. Note 1: Qualifications are relaxable at the discretion of the Competent Authority in the case of candidates otherwise well qualified. Note 2: Qualification(s) regarding experience is relaxable at the discretion of the competent authority in the case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes if at any stage of selection the competent authority is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the vacancy reserved for them
