> **Guidelines for Oral Presentation** (UG and PG Students & others category)

The instructions for the preparation of Oral Presentation (for selected submissions)

- 1. All presenters must prepare PPT, outlining key findings and conclusions.
- It should be clear, well-organized, informative and concise and should include all necessary information (Title, Aim, Methods, Research findings, Results/Outcomes, Discussion, Recommendation, References).
- 3. Presenters must be mindful of their time slot and should not exceed the time limit of 6 minutes for Presentation and 2 minutes for Discussion.
- 4. Make sure that any photographs / figures or radiographs used in PPT are clearly visible with sufficient size and high resolution.
- 5. Photographs used for case report presentation should be masked properly as per ethical guidelines.
- 6. Do not submit any photographs or pictures that are not relevant to the text, such as cartoon characters, etc. (Photographs for case report presentation should be in standard quality).
